- 9.) **Save the Date (Spring Concert)** will be Monday May 5th with the concert starting at 7:00 p.m.
- 10.) **Save the Date (Field Day)** will be in the afternoon of Monday May 19th.

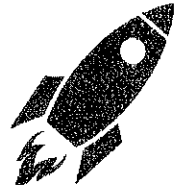

EDIBLE BOOK CONTEST



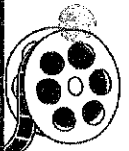
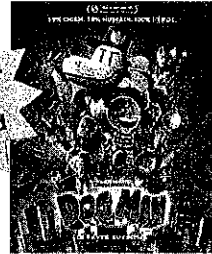

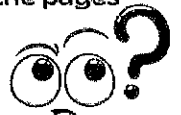
