- 14.) **Awards** will be at 9:00 a.m. Tuesday May 14th with dismissal at 2:00 p.m. for the **last day** of school.




Thanks again to everyone for their support of Randolph Elementary! It truly takes a team, and I am glad to be on this great team with all our stakeholders at Randolph Elementary.
